At this year's ALRC AGM, which will take place at 10.00am on the 18<sup>th</sup> March 2017 at The British Motor Museum, Banbury Road, Gaydon, CV35 0BJ the following members of the ALRC Council are due to stand down under the three year rotation and are seeking re-election:

Any further nominations for either committee need to be received at the above address by the 17th March 2017 or in person at the meeting.

Nominations must be received on club headed paper from a member club with signatures from a proposer and seconder.

Members are reminded that to be elected on to either committee means a commitment to attend the meetings held three times a year at The British Motor Museum, Gaydon.

Council meetings are held in February, June and October, General and S&ORC meetings are held in March, July and November. If you require any further information then please contact me.

Voting will take place at the meeting and votes for both committees will only be accepted from clubs that have paid their 2017 ALRC subscription prior to the meeting.

Votes should be given by the club secretary or named delegate from the club.

Included with this letter is a copy of the ALRC financial statement for the year ending 31<sup>st</sup> December 2016 which were agreed by the ALRC Council on the 4<sup>th</sup> February 2017.

Derek Spooner will discuss this financial statement further in his report at the forthcoming ALRC AGM.

May I also take this opportunity to remind competitive clubs that the rule change proposal in the Modified Class Vehicle Regulations will also be voted on at the ALRC AGM and that forms previously issued to club secretaries can be returned to the above address or in person at the meeting.

**Re: Q Class Vehicles**

There has been much discussion as to how vehicles that enter events can be identified to make sure they are safe to do so especially in the case of CCVT's and Comp Safaris where roll cages are required and competitors must have an ALRC logbook.

It was agreed at the ALRC Council Meeting held on the 4<sup>th</sup> February 2017 that the following will be carried out for the two year trial period up to the end of December 2018 where the results will be studied and an informed decision made as to the success or failure of the trial.

Vehicles with roll cages will be issued with a yellow tag and the initial scrutineering paperwork showing clearly that the vehicle is a Q Class. Two photographs should be provided and the yellow tag number should be written on these. The competitor should then keep this paperwork to show at future events.

It is not intended that an ALRC log book will be issued for a Q class vehicle during the trial period.

Clubs are reminded that there is no compulsion to take part in this trial and allow Q class vehicles at their events. Clubs not wishing to take part should include an Additional Supplementary Regulation excluding Q class from their events.

I would be grateful if the above information can be circulated to your club members and I look forward to seeing you or your club delegate at the AGM.
