#### N.B. SECTION U – PRIVILEGE EVENTS

- U.1. ALRC member clubs may invite non-ALRC member, Motorsport UK registered clubs to compete in a maximum of eight events in any one calendar year. The definition of an event is 1 Motorsport UK permit = 1 privilege event application.
- U.2. Prior written approval of the invitation must be obtained from the ALRC Secretary.
- U.3. Events must be held under a Motorsport UK event permit applied for by the host club.
- U.4. Events must be held under Motorsport UK regulations, ALRC regulations and any ASR's as required by the host club.
- U.5. ALRC club members entering an event using an ALRC member club membership card must enter using an ALRC compliant vehicle. They may not enter a non-ALRC compliant vehicle unless they enter using a non-ALRC club membership card.
